(This Amendment shall be treated as part of the all Pre-qualification Documents mentioned above)

1. Due to national holiday on 27th May (Thursday), Pre-qualification Closing Date shall be 30th May, 2010 at 1200 hours Bangladesh Standard Time (BST) instead of 27th May, 2010 at 1200 hours Bangladesh Standard Time (BST).
2. In Section H 1.4.2 the following sentence is to be added as the last sentence:
"Any consortium Member can not participate with more than one Applicant."

Clarification to the PQ Document

1. Please clarify whether each and every power project has to have operated for no less than one year to be aggregated. Or any individual project can also be considered as "successful" if it is being operated for less than one year after its COD and can be aggregated?

Ans: As per provision of PQ, each and every power project has to have operated "successfully" for no less than one year to be aggregated.

2. If a power producer has to seek for legal assistances from any arbitration administrator to protect its rights against a government owned or controlled entity or power off-taker/purchaser, should it be termed as a 'dispute'?

Ans: Please follow the provision of Pre-qualification document.

3. "Pre-qualified Applicants shall not be permitted to form a consortium to submit a proposal/bid", however, please clarify whether in the pre-qualification process any company can form several consortium with different companies to bid for separate projects?

Ans: Please follow the provision of Pre-qualification document.

4. Can the audited balance sheet be submitted not in accordance with IAS or GAAP?

Ans: Please follow the provision of Pre-qualification document.

5. The Gas/HFO receiving facilities including metering arrangement (as the case may be) shall be the responsibility of Fuel Supplier.

Ans: Please follow the provision of Pre-qualification document.
